UNIFORM REQUIREMENTS

- School shirt **OR** plain red T-shirt **OR** red polo shirt.
- Navy blue shorts **OR** Navy blue skirt or skort.
- Plain navy blue pants or track pants.
- School rugby sweater/zip jacket or plain navy blue top.
- Navy broad brimmed hats / Legionnaire sun smart hats / bucket hats are compulsory all year round for outdoor activities. Beanies, hoods and baseball caps are not acceptable as hats (unless with a note from parent).
- Appropriate closed-in footwear with a covered toe.

IT'S TIME TO ENROL FOR 2021

We are now taking applications for enrolment. You need to enrol for:

- Kindergarten - four years old by 30 June 2020
- Pre-primary (first year of compulsory school) – 5 years old by 30 June 2020
- changing schools
- All children from Pre-primary to Year 12 are guaranteed a place at their local public school.

Remember to bring Birth Certificates, proof of address and immunisation statements. If you have friends, neighbours or relatives that have children that are eligible we would encourage you to come to school to find out about programs and have a tour of our school.

SLPS DENTAL SCREEN

Screening involves all enrolled children lining up in alphabetical order and presenting to the Dental Officer one after the other. The Dental Officer may **use some single-use pop sticks to retract each child's lips and assess how he/she bites his/her teeth together**. This exercise will take **no longer than 20secs per child**. Please be assured that a **new set of pop sticks will be used to screen each child**.

IF YOUR CHILD IS UNWELL

As the winter season advances so does the increase of cold and flu sickness. We would ask that students be kept home when they are sick. Your actions will help prevent the spread of illness throughout the school. **Please remind your child to:**

- Frequently wash their hands for at least 20 seconds with soap and water, or using an alcohol-based hand gel;
- Refraining from touching the mouth and nose;
- If coughing or sneezing, covering their nose and mouth with a paper tissue or flexed elbow; and dispose of the tissue immediately after use and perform hand hygiene.
